End of Reception

71% of Reception pupils attained Good Level of Development (GLD).

Year One Phonics

77% of children have passed the Phonics screening at the end of Year One.

In Year Two, 75% of children who were required to retake the Y1 phonic test were successful.

End of Key Stage One and Two

Children have been assessed as at, above or below National expectations for the first time this year with greatly increased expectations. **As Nicky Morgan, the Education Secretary reiterated during her time in office:** "This is the first year we have assessed pupils under the new more rigorous system and it is no surprise that this year's results look different to previous years.
